

Teacher Workshop

How to Build and Use a Telescope



Join the Clark Planetarium this summer for an intensive 3-day astronomy workshop. Participants will explore the night sky and learn to find their way around in it, as well as learn all about telescopes with ample hands-on experience in telescope use and construction.

Camps are open to any Utah teachers. Camps are mixed attendance with 12 kids and 4-6 teachers per camp. Each teacher participant will receive a 8-inch Dobsonian telescope (valued at \$349), star charts, and astronomy materials, including a copy of Starry Night (valued at \$169). Tuition is only \$100 per person (\$50 for Title I school teachers) as a result of grant funds from the State of Utah.

As part of the registration, please write up a short (up to one page in length) description of what you (and your school) would do educationally with the telescope and provided materials. Preference will be shown to teachers able to use these resources for the benefit of their schools. Date of application will also be considered.
